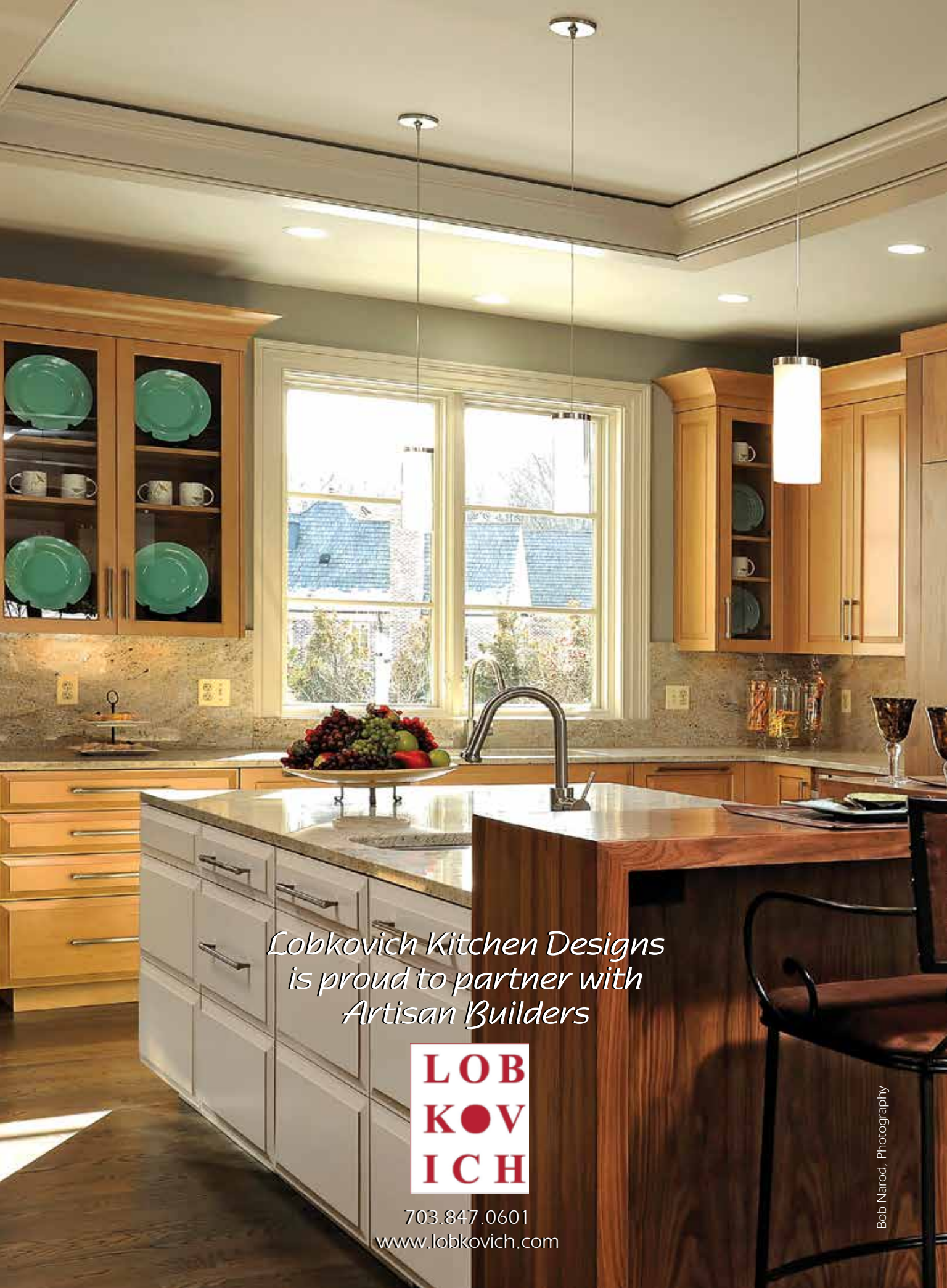

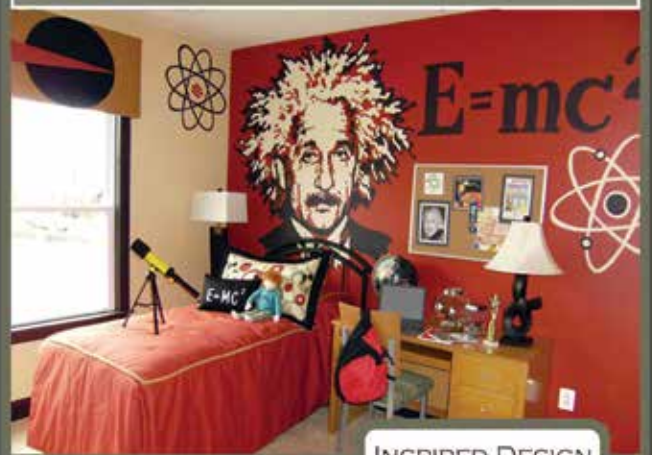

24 Designers Reveal the Rich Tradition of the Old Dominion in a New Country Estate

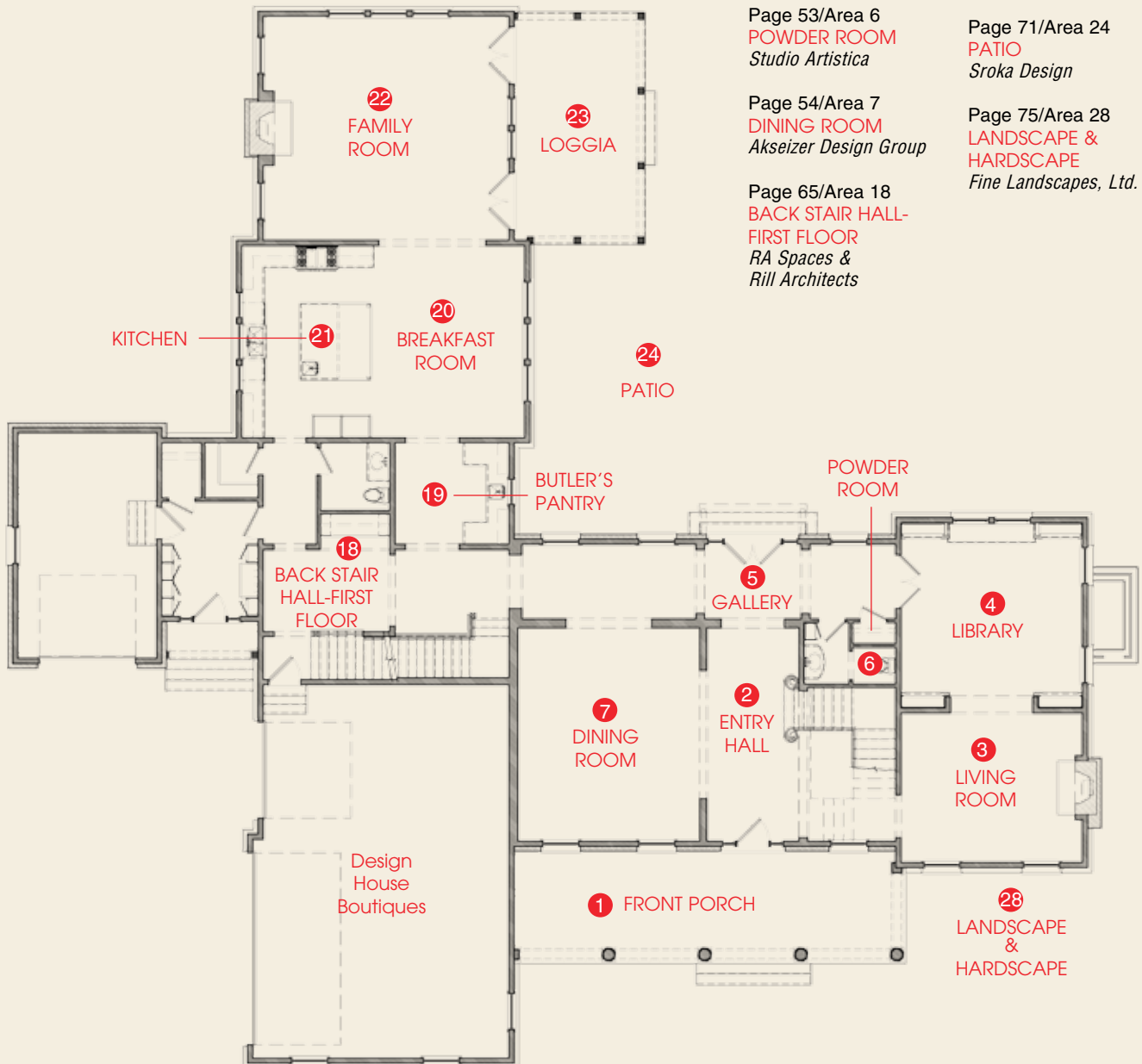
Built by Artisan Builders and designed by Harrison Design, the 8,869-square-foot home replicates an Old American Farmhouse as a nod to Virginia's rich countryside, while also offering all the amenities of modern living. By designing the home in parts, rather than as a whole, it appears to have been added onto over the years. The interior floor plan is an L shape, which was popular among early farmers because of the ease and efficiency of adding future rooms. The modern farmhouse offers light-filled interior rooms that blend old elements such as reclaimed wood and antiques with new features, including top-of-the-line kitchen appliances. A gallery finished with stone from an old Virginia

farmhouse and a library paneled in quartersawn oak are among the vintage touches. The exterior is distinguished by covered porches, antique-style lighting and natural stone in a random, hand-cut pattern. This elegant new farmhouse is situated in one of the most sought after communities in McLean, Virginia. Henry Mackall, circa 1800, once owned this land and its neighboring property, Langley Farm. Wisely, Henry kept the best land for last and in honor of his foresight for location and beauty, the community of twelve homes was christened Mackall Farms in 2013.

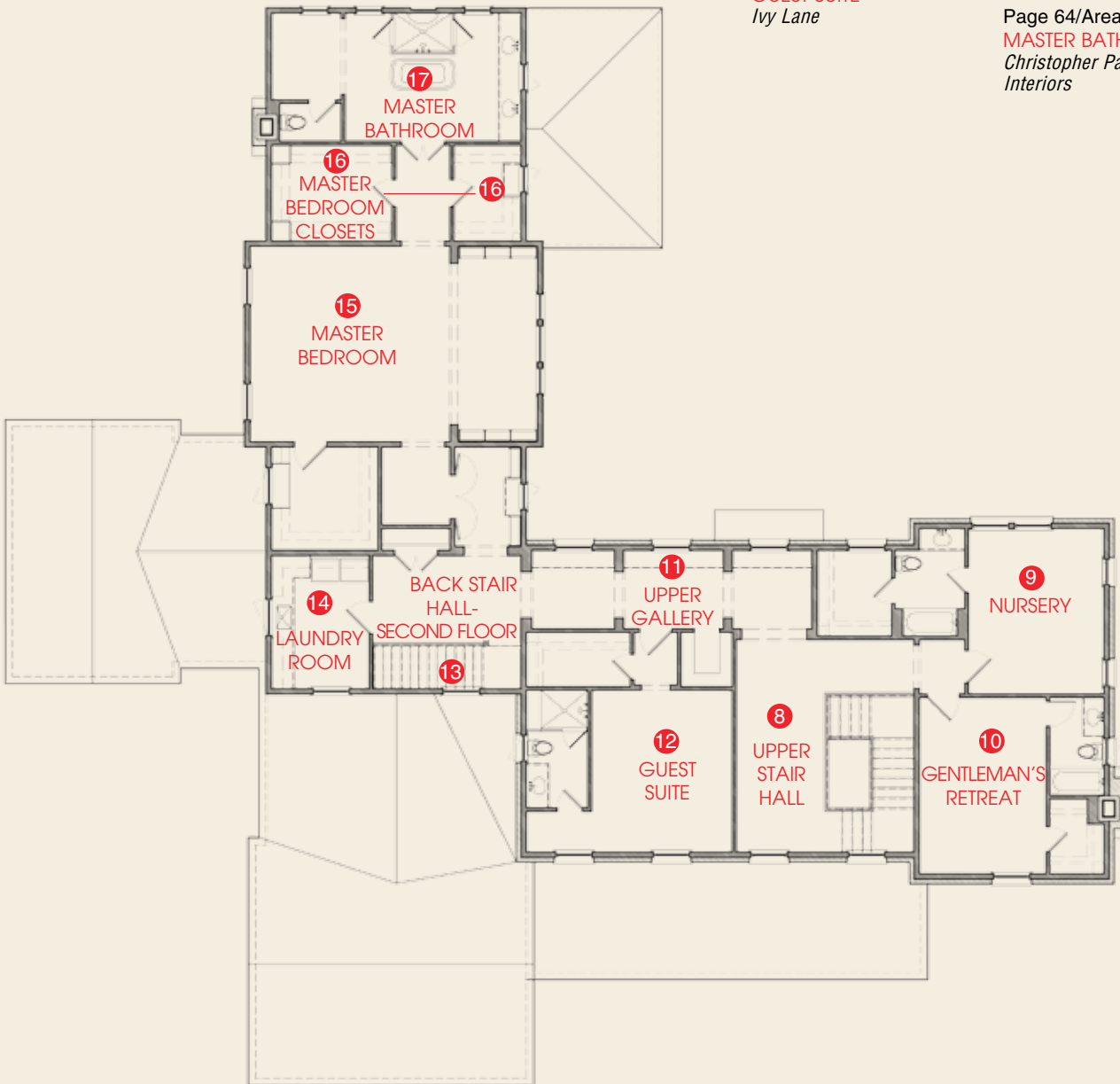

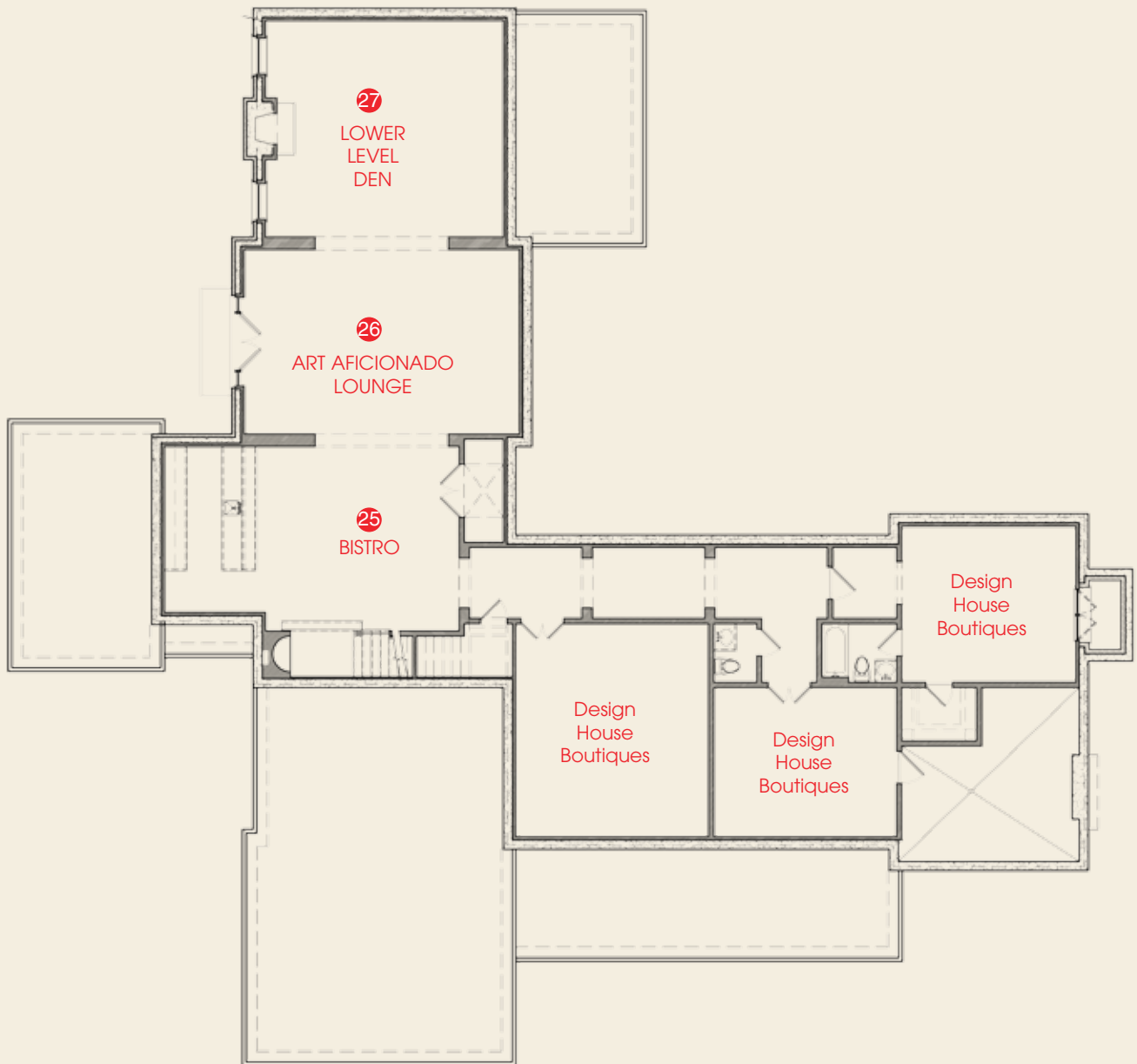

AREA 2 ENTRY HALL

Casual Elegance may be somewhat a contradiction in terms, but it aptly describes the look of this welcoming entryway. Our challenge was to create a modern space with a hint of glamour, while respecting the home's farmhouse-inspired architecture. Through unexpected color, sophisticated finishes and stylish geometrics we struck a relaxed, yet polished note. The informal slat-board ceiling received a coat of high-gloss pink paint. Two sculptural hanging pendants add more sparkle overhead. For continuity, we wove other blossom-hued and warm metallic accents throughout the space. A pair of brass sconces flanks the dining room opening. The fixtures' interlocking ovals and dramatic color combination are repeated on the demilune table opposite them. Gilt-framed, abstract artwork reinforces the modern-elegance aesthetic. Simple drapery panels, crafted in petal pink linen, adorn the window. Earth-toned elements, such as the wool and silk rug, balance out the more feminine ones and echo the home's interior and exterior stonework. A Beacon Hill fabric with an immense pattern in smoky shades covers the stairway wall and beckons guests.

AREA 3 LIVING ROOM

Streamlined and fashion forward, but with comfort in mind. These are the tenets to which we designed this living room. Setting the mood with custom handpainted, embrodered silk wallcovering surrounding the fireplace wall and the ceiling, we played up the organic qualities this home exudes. Colors found in the stone and wood throughout the home, such as cocoa, latte, silver and cool blue were included in the upholstery and window treatment textiles. We continued the organic journey using bird's eye maple on a console, but packaged it in cashmere grey, then introduced it again with walnut in a geometric coffee table. Side tables with printed hide tops made us swoon while their open brass bases opened up a dialogue for using metal accents in art. Photography over the console is printed on metal. Sculpture cast in bronze is placed on a pedestal under our vista of flowering branches near the small but distinctive drink table. Original, contemporary paintings residing over the sofa complete the journey, begging one to stay, recharge and take stock of nature's wonder.

AREA 4 LIBRARY

Inspired by American farmhouse and Greek revival style, the library reflects the relaxed, classic spirit of the architecture while embracing the comforts and lifestyles of the 21st century. I envision the library as a quiet and comfortable retreat for a distinguished family who has traveled the world yet has distinctly American tastes. My approach was to create relaxed formality while including elements of exoticism and richness. AREA 8 UPPER STAIR HALL

This upper hall invites inhabitants and guests to linger, rather than quickly pass through. Bold elements garner immediate interest, while whimsical touches, understated details and rich textures encourage closer inspection. An oversize Ro Sham Beaux chandelier with ivory-colored beads and metallic hemp lends drama. A jaunty peacock painting provides design inspiration. The artwork, sure to bring a smile, receives pride of place in the sitting area, a perfect spot to peruse the morning paper. Two modern wing chairs from CR Laine are slip-covered in a soft, brushed flannel from Robert Allen's Wool Suit line. Another fabric, in Beacon Hill's worldly Water Diamond pattern, covers the walls and provides a textural backdrop. Tucked beneath the zinc-topped console table is a bench covered in luxurious baby ocelot faux fur, a nod to the space's animal inspiration. At the end of the hall a cushioned window seat, with open storage for books underneath, creates a comfy reading nook. The covered books stacked there playfully display a quote from fashion designer Tom Ford: "When you find somebody good, keep them in your life."

AREA 10 GENTLEMAN'S RETREAT

The aesthetic of the "Gentleman's Retreat" was gleaned from the flavor and detailing of the house itself. The showhouse features exposed stone walls and wide plank flooring, as well as two over two paned windows - indicative of a 19th century farm dwelling. This bedroom was designed to be a masculine mix of the antique and the modern, executed in a monochromatic color story. In keeping with the rustic theme, texture is the main design element; a textured herringbone rug graces the floor, and the walls are covered with a roughly textured paneling wallpaper. The window coverings are 19th century styled paneled shutters in stained pine; the bed is an 18th century canopy bed with monochromatic bed hangings. The large chest-of-drawers is early 19th century, and the drop-leaf bedside table is a late 18th century antique. The artwork in the room is a mix of modern monochromatic photography and abstract drawings. The disparate elements come together to form a visually interesting mix of the old and new, coordinated with the color story and play on texture.

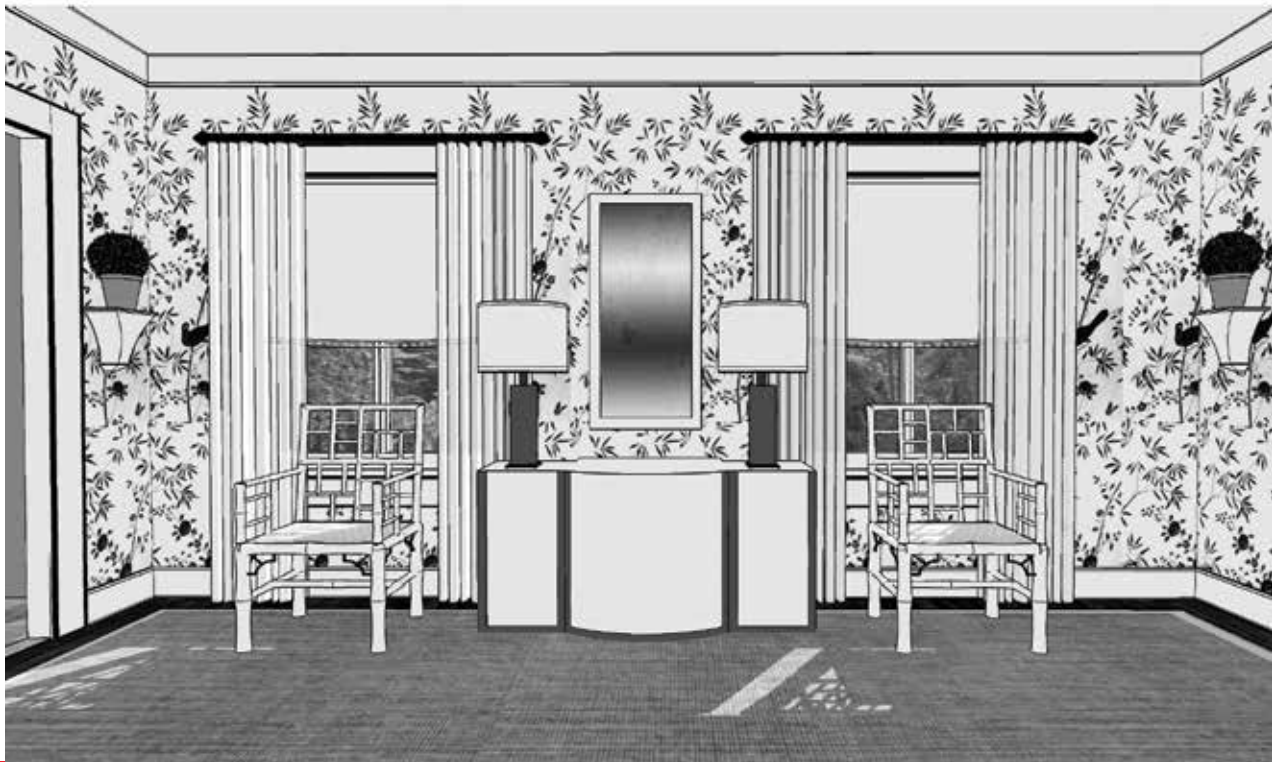

While the space has the feel of an art gallery, with the large windows and doorways, what the room is lacking is usable wall space. The Design Concept: make the walls the art! First, we commissioned artist Gary Goldberg to hand paint the walls in the classic style of a Gracie Wallpaper - climbing vines, birds, gilded cages and maybe, a rabbit or two. We then added draperies made by Yardstick Interiors, a rug from J. Brooks, a table by Kiwi Custom Carpentry and a hanging lantern by Coleen & Company to create the airy look. Since the Design House is in Virginia this year, I wanted to give a nod to two stylish Virginians -- both named Bunny: Bunny Mellon, who loved hand-painted walls and topiaries, and Bunny Williams, since I've specified a mirror from her collection. A "bunny" theme? The pièce de résistance - a fantastic original Neo-Expressionist oil painting by Hunt Slonem, "Untitled Bunnies," provided by Lee Jofa / Kravet.

We created a serene and inviting space while still incorporating color and visual excitement. So often it is assumed that serenity within a room can only be achieved by using traditionally neutral colors. We achieved that sense of calm by layering without over-embellishing, using texture and sheen, and enveloping the guest using softly contrasting colors. The wallpaper is a custom design on muslin by Ann McGuire Studio for Ivy Lane. Ann used the same pattern from the walls to create custom linen window treatments and upholstery fabric for the bed frame. The duvet cover and shams in Belgian linen and piped in lilac velvet are a custom design made by Ivy Lane Linens boutique. The night stands on either side of the bed were custom-lacquered for the guest suite by Codor Design. Across from the bed is a cabinet by Hickory Chair. Next to the cabinet is a custom Ivy Lane private label chair covered in a Nobilis fabric.

First, we selected the graphic “Cow Parsley” wallpaper by Cole and Son to create a dramatic backdrop and enforce the connection to the first floor. Like the house, which feels like it has been added to over time, we wanted the interior to feel like an acquired collection of pieces. The “Nuvola Rossa” shelving from Cassina is a sculptural as well as functional 1970’s classic. The useful storage bench and custom sweater rug give the space warmth and style. Utilizing vintage and worn subject matter made fresh by its mounting and scale, local photographer Charlie Gaynor exemplifies the room’s contemporary vintage aesthetic. AREA 14 LAUNDRY ROOM

Who says Laundry Rooms have to be boring? Our “Glam-A-Rama” brings a touch of glamour to an otherwise mundane room. Inspiration came from the mottled grey-green ceramic floors and granite countertops. We enhanced these natural elements with a custom wallcovering made of crushed oyster shells, giving the room texture, dimension and a subtle shimmer from the abundant natural light. Printed velvet in an Ikat motif from Osborne and Little is used in a simple yet elegant window treatment. A hand-woven area rug in shades of green and grey by Doris Leslie Blau gives dimension to the floor. Shadowbox moulding above the washer and dryer offsets a shimmering pale green backdrop to highlight a collection of framed Intaglios, each representing a Greek God or Goddess. A grey lacquered chest serves as additional storage and the base for a contemporary painting by Brandt Williams. A lamp with a crystal prism shade provides a rainbow of light. Our favorite design element is our Jeweled Bangle Drying Rack, where bracelets designed by Dina Mackney Designs are suspended from a Swarovski crystal encrusted drapery rod.

The master bathroom design is centered around the focal point of the room: the exposed fieldstone wall. The texture and colors had a heavy influence on my selections for finishes in the paint and accessories. Kohler fixtures add the perfect level of sophistication to the composition. An area rug was used to add warmth underfoot. A Niermann Weeks custom chandelier hangs overhead bringing the scale of the room down and adding a little gilt to contrast with the earthiness of the stone. Less is more in this bathroom, opting for minimal decoration and accessories; simple linen shades create privacy while softening the space. 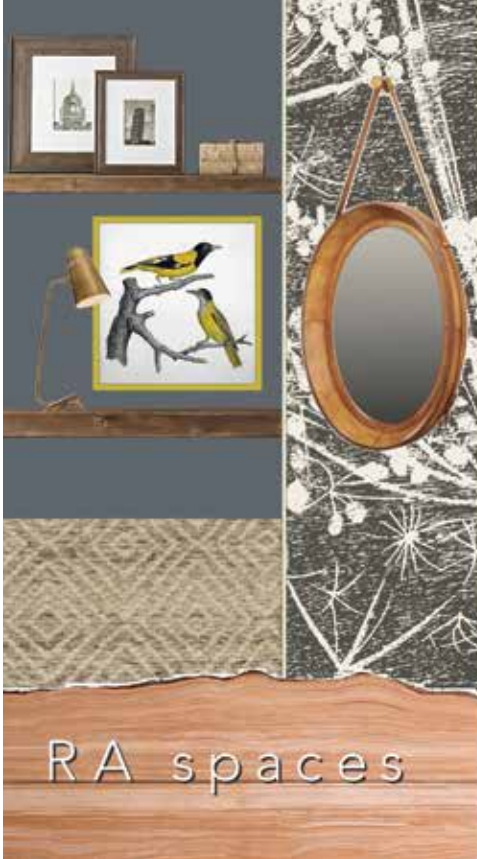

The connection between garage, mudroom and kitchen is anchored by the console table and wool rug. The locally commissioned painting "Old Dominion Sky" brings a focal point and virtual window to this end of the hall. The built-in desk functions as an organization and display area. The open wood shelving adds a practical attractive bonus. The bold wallpaper, the Circa Lighting chandelier, tufted bench and photo art on the lower level all deliver fresh takes on period furnishings. The classic Eames bright blue fiberglass shell chair introduces an unexpected Americana twist.

AREA 19 BUTLER'S PANTRY

What do you think of when you hear Butler's Pantry? For some it might conjure images of historic British homes like those seen in the hit TV series *Downton Abbey*. However, this Butler's Pantry is far more updated, fresh and warm than its historical counterparts. This modern farmhouse kitchen and breakfast area offers a light-filled room that blends antiques with new updated furniture. The farm kitchen table is French 19th Century. The space is used on a daily basis so the Lee dining chairs are covered in a Sunbrella washable outdoor fabric and the Lee counter stools in leather. The curtains are Lee Jofa "Tidewater Block," a hand block print, but used on the wrong side to give a softer look. The soft oriental rug from Stark completes the room. The Breakfast Room is dedicated to Sandy Steele, an unflappable cheerleader of the design community and the DC Design House.

AREA 21 KITCHEN

This kitchen design was inspired by the works of architect Robert A. M. Stern. His classic vernacular “American” vocabulary was our starting point for creating a kitchen that embodies both classic and contemporary elements. We chose to use a custom cabinetry door-style for this kitchen, with an unusual two-panel detail in the wall cabinets. The lower panel is the smaller panel, and this emphasizes the height of the upper panel, which is much like a detail seen in a classic skyscraper building. Harmony and simplicity were created by having the majority of the kitchen painted in one color, “Antique White,” with accent areas of American black walnut wood (seen in the inset cabinetry of the refrigerator wall and the island legs). A luxuriously simple custom-made hood, executed in blackened steel and stainless steel, accents the range area in the wall and evokes the pattern and texture of standing seam roofs of farmhouses. Simple, yet elegant in its details, this kitchen captures all the elements of a classical kitchen, but in a way that is both fresh and exciting.

AREA 25 BISTRO

I wanted a casual but sophisticated atmosphere where the furnishings balanced the mass of the stone and wood of the bar area. I chose as the focal point of the lounge seating area a handcrafted “Silver Lining” pendant by Tracy Glover. The cool hues and delicate patterns of the large, handblown glass globes perfectly counterbalance the warm, rustic aesthetic in the bar. American Leather’s Cole Chair is covered in Romo’s Indigo Satin Lambswool so they are at once chic, refined and casual. The chairs surround a hammered metal cocktail table to create an intimate conversation setting, all of which sit on Surya’s new 100% Hemp Scarborough rug. I dressed the back of the bar with an Indigo glass tile and introduced Italian chocolate leather and Wenge barstools. The walls are alternatively painted in deep indigo and French gold as well as covered in Jessica Zoob’s “Dreaming” Frost wallcovering – a watery, organic abstract in counterpoint to the earth-bound stone. No room is complete without great art, which I chose to command the space in balance with the drama of the bar.

AREA 28

LANDSCAPE AND HARDSCAPE

With great design sequence, the landscape and hardscape materials for the Mackall Farms home have been chosen to complement the Farm-House-styled architecture. The front includes a low wall, paver auto court, fountain and complementary landscaping. The front autocourt in brick is anchored at the corner with a well pump. The use of brick as a paving element is true to the époque contemplated for the house. The antique horse trough and well pump from the mid 1800's are part of the antique garden ornaments collected by designer Charles Owen on his trips through France. At the side yard, the Pennsylvania flat stack fieldstone walls and associated water feature evoke a falling water approach to the rear garden; while the rear gardens host a series of garden landscaping, garden walks, brick patio and firepit terrace to provide circulation and intimate outdoor living rooms. The horticulture includes a classically assembled palette of deer resistant plants that offer complementary color and texture. The mature screening plants along the property line provide a tall, green privacy hedge between neighboring properties.

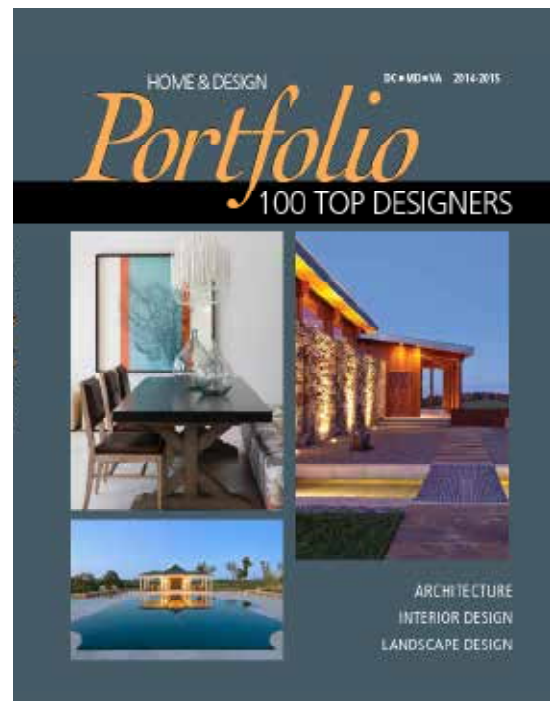
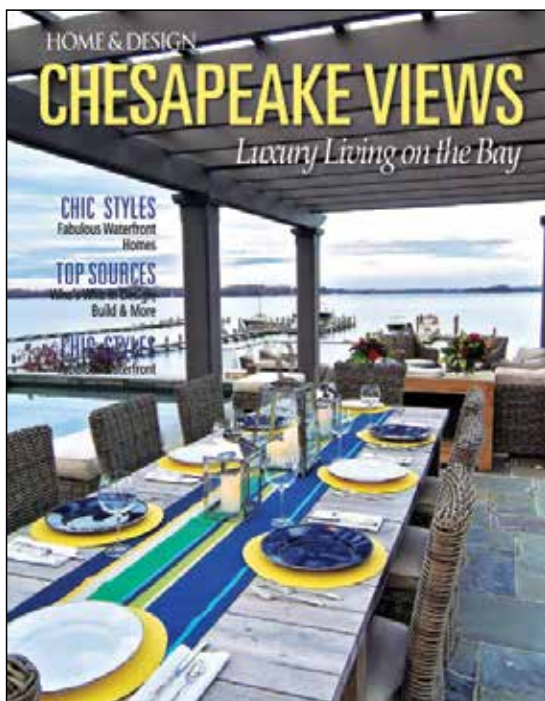

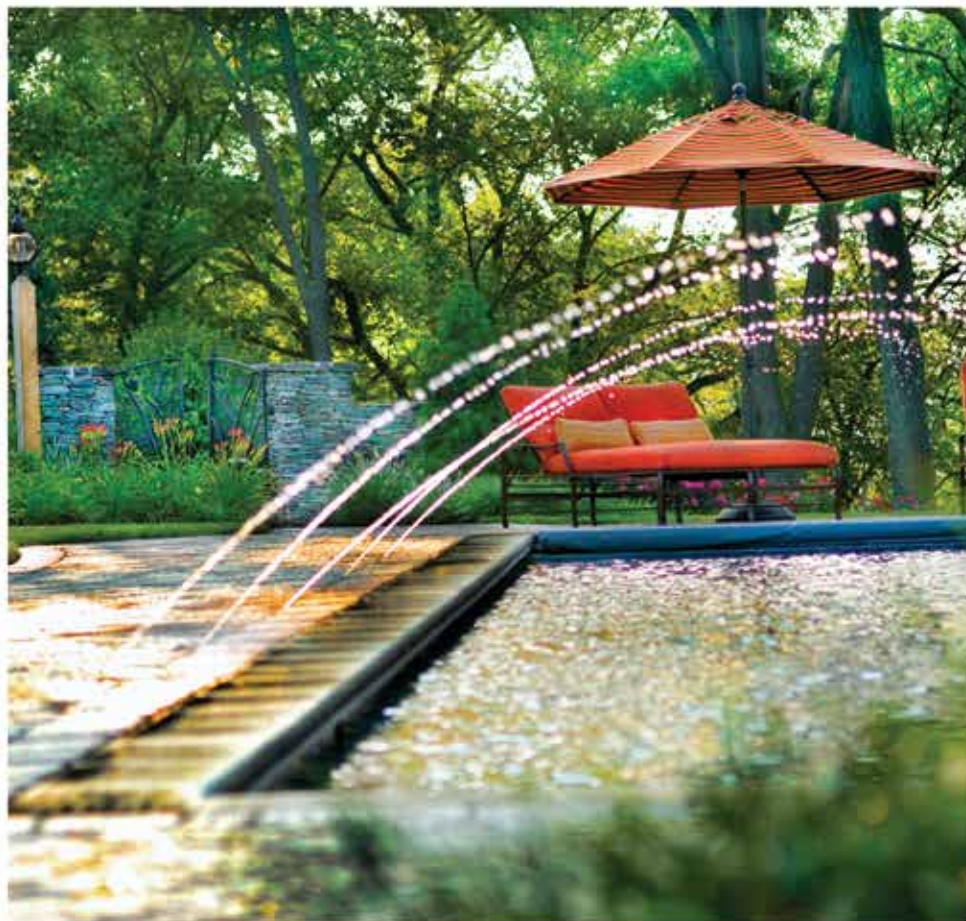
